

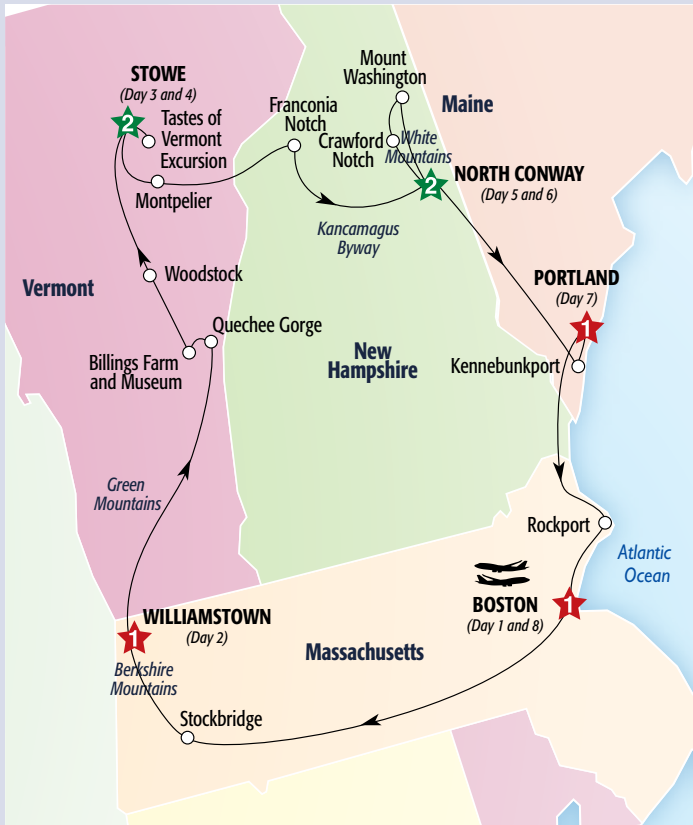

DAY 1 - SAT 6 OCT 2018

ARRIVE BOSTON

DAY 2 - SUN 7 OCT 2018

BEANTOWN TO WILLIAMSTOWN

Discover some of Boston's most famous sights as your Travel Director takes you along a section of the Freedom Trail. Then, enjoy the colourful scenery as you travel west to Stockbridge for a visit to the Norman Rockwell Museum, the largest and most significant collection of original Rockwell art. Travel through the stunning rolling hills of the Berkshires to your hotel in the beautiful college town of Williamstown. (FB, D)

DAY 3 - MON 8 OCT 2018

THE LEGENDS OF THE FALL AND STOWE

Leave Massachusetts to journey through the legendary fall foliage of Vermont. Visit The Apple Barn Country Bake Shop and taste fresh cider in the making. Visit the Rockefeller's renowned Billings Farm and Museum, a working dairy and farm life museum, before a stop in the quintessential Vermont village of Woodstock with its picturesque covered bridge. Arrive in Stowe, Vermont, the breathtaking alpine setting that attracted the real Von Trapp family of 'The Sound of Music' fame when they travelled from Austria in the late 1940s. At tonight's Highlight Dinner, each of the three inspired courses are perfectly paired with a lager tasting from your resort's on-site microbrewery. (FB, DW)

DAY 4 - TUE 9 OCT 2018

A TASTE OF VERMONT

[RS] Today, enjoy beautiful scenery ablaze with fall colours. Sample flavours of a different kind on a guided tour of Ben and Jerry's Ice Cream Factory. Return to the charming town of Stowe where the rest of the day is yours to wander the quaint streets, hike in the woods, or enjoy your lodge's amenities. (FB)

DAY 5 - WED 10 OCT 2018

NORTH CONWAY AND THE WHITE MOUNTAINS

Near Montpelier, visit Morse Farm Maple Sugarworks and taste a Vermont tradition: 'sugar on snow' - maple syrup served with a doughnut and pickle. Then head for New Hampshire's White Mountains and enter Franconia Notch. Get your cameras ready for a ride on the aerial tramway offering superb panoramic views. Later, journey through the dazzling crimson and orange hues of the famed Kancamagus Scenic Byway to North Conway. (FB, DW)

DAY 6 - THU 11 OCT 2018

SIGHTSEEING IN THE WHITE MOUNTAINS

[RS] This morning, enjoy an insightful presentation by a naturalist on the North Woods' wildlife and ecology. Then, more spectacular fall foliage awaits as you journey through Crawford Notch. Stop for pictures at the Silver Cascade Waterfall and Bretton Woods, offering stunning views of Mount Washington, the tallest peak in the northeast at 6,288 feet (1,917 metres). Return to your hotel where the evening is at leisure. (FB)

DAY 7 - FRI 12 OCT 2018

THE RUGGED MAINE COAST TO PORTLAND

[RS] Leaving New Hampshire's glorious fall foliage, enter the deep green pine forests of western Maine. In charming Kennebunkport, travel along Ocean Drive with stunning views of the Maine coastline and the homes of Kennebunkport's rich and famous, including the summer retreat of former President George H.W. Bush. There will be time to browse the many galleries and shops, or walk along the waterfront before continuing to historic Portland. In the evening, enjoy a Celebration Dinner with your fellow travellers. (FB, DW)

DAY 8 - SAT 13 OCT 2018

BACK TO BOSTON.

Continue south to the charming Nubble Lighthouse before driving back to Boston. Stops will be made at Boston Logan International Airport and the Boston tour hotel for guests wishing to extend their stay. Airport arrival will be 14:30. (FB)
